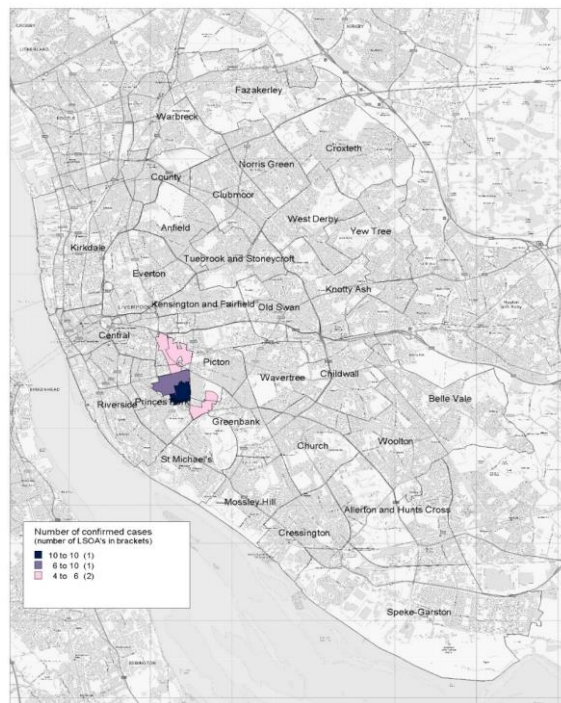
Total confirmed cases for Liverpool in the last 7 days is **68**, increase of 35 from previous week

Liverpool confirmed COVID-19 cases have been increasing rapidly since around the 20th July, when there were around 14 cases per week to the current level of 68 cases

The ward with the largest number of confirmed cases is Princes park (18 cases), followed by Picton ward (9 cases), then Greenbank & Wavertree wards (5 cases)
